### FEE WAIVER POLICY

It is the policy of the parks and recreation department that no child be denied access to basic recreation services because of inability to pay. The department will consider fee waiver requests based on a family's present financial status.

Fee waiver requests will be taken for youth, ages 0 –17 years of age, for all recreation services.

Parents/Guardians must complete the recreation scholarship request forms and provide the required support documentation at the time of registration.



### DISCOUNT POLICY

Each individual that registers for a program during the designated Registration Week will receive a \$10 discount. This discount does not apply to sports camps, golf, swim team, swim lessons, summer camps, or after school care. These programs may have their own discounts.

An individual registering for multi-programs in one quarter will receive a \$5.00 discount on the total cost of the applied-for programs. Family members registering for the same program in the same quarter may receive the \$5.00 discount on the total cost of their combined programs. This does not apply to the instructional programs of tennis, swimming, etc.

### AGE CONTROL DATE POLICY

### OUT OF COUNTY POLICY

All the participants living outside of Bulloch County registering for programs will be required to pay an additional \$10.00 out-of-county fee for each activity, each season or month.

### REFUND POLICY

Refunds will not be issued for withdrawal from a program that meets the minimum enrollment requirements set by the department, except in the following cases: Cancellation by the registrant prior to one week before the program starts will result in a full refund. Cancellation by registrant one week or less prior to the program starting date will result in a full refund minus a \$3.00 service charge. **NO REFUND WILL BE GIVEN AFTER A PROGRAM HAS STARTED.**

Parents, we know you and your children are excited about the upcoming Summer! We are just as excited because we are gearing up for Summer Camp! This year, we are combining age levels and will only have two camps—Camp Cherokee and Camp Tomahawk. We will finalize all camp sites by May 20, 2011.

The grade level for each camp is the grade the child has COMPLETED as of May 2010!

All camps meet Monday through Friday. Weekly sessions are offered beginning May 31 and ending July 29<sup>th</sup>. The camps fill up fast and there is limited space – so register early. T-shirts or other items are included in the price and are given out each week – usually on fieldtrip days. There are additional fees for field trips.

Discounts will be given for each week of camp (\$10.00 discount) and extended care (\$5.00 discount) paid for during registration.

EARLY CARE (from 7:15- 7:50 AM) is also available at the cost of \$5/week.

### PAYMENT POLICY

Pre-payment for ALL sessions is required (camp fee only – extended care may be paid weekly) in order to hold a spot for your child. (\*note discounts above!) We accept Visa/ MasterCard/Discover, check or cash. In order to assist parents with the large sums required for camp – we split our payments up. If you are registering for at least 4 weeks of camp – you may split those camp payment fees in 3 payments. One check is due at registration. A second check can be post-dated for May 27; and a third check can be post-dated for June 27. Those checks must be left with our office for deposit on those dates.

### EXTENDED CARE

Registration and payment can be paid on a weekly basis. However, discounts are only available during the week of registration. You must register and pay on the Wednesday prior to the week that care is needed. IMPORTANT: Any child who is at camp *after 2:05pm* will be considered an extended care participant for that day and will be charged accordingly (even if the child is picked up by 2:15pm).

### REFUND/TRANSFER FEE

\$10.00 per refund or transfer made after initial registration. Please make every effort to finalize your summer care needs PRIOR to camp registration so that you can avoid these fees. Two weeks notice required for any refund request --no exceptions.

### LUNCH

Children will need to BRING THEIR OWN LUNCH each day.



### DAILY ACTIVITY SCHEDULE FOR SUMMER DAY CAMP!

**Camp Drop Off:** Staff will be greeting parents outside from 7:50-8:15 am. If arriving after 8:15 am, you will need to escort your child inside. Early care is available beginning 7:15 am (\$5 per week--must be prepaid)—you must walk your child inside and sign in.

Please remember that all times are approximate, and that some activities will vary daily! All activity days are subject to change depending on camp changes!

10:00am – 11:15am Swim Time at Splash in the Boro Waterpark  
Camp Cherokee will swim on Mondays (Kindergarten) and Wednesdays (Pre-K) each week.  
Camp Tomahawk will swim on Tuesdays and Thursdays each week.

Wear your swimsuit under clothing in the mornings. Bring change of clothes, towel, tennis shoes, and sunscreen. You can wear flip flops or sandals to the waterpark. We will leave camp at 9:30 for swim time. Be on time! Parents may NOT take children to Splash in the Boro after we have left the camp site. We will return to camp around 11:30 am. If your child is sensitive to sun—please sunscreen in the morning before leaving home. Be sure to speak with the group leader if sunscreen needs to be reapplied often. Put child's name on EVERYTHING!

**Pickup:** Requires parents to come inside and sign your child out. PLEASE use your child's pick up card. THIS IS FOR YOUR CHILD'S SAFETY! Even if you know the staff, and the staff knows you, please USE the cards. Sign IN and OUT every day! We rely on these Check in/out sheets for safety of the children, as well as, in our participation numbers for activities throughout the day. We also ask for patience during pickup. We utilize many different spaces at the schools, which means we have to spread out. Parents are welcome to visit camp to see the fun your child(ren) is (are) having! This would also allow you a chance to speak with camp counselors!

#### Additional Activities

Daily activities at camp will include: art, science, games, reading, centers – younger children (blocks, legos, coloring, dress up, dramatic play, etc.), computers, playground activities, music, fitness (yes, we have fitness activities everyday!), etc. Activities are based on weekly themes that are developed by the camp staff.

#### Summer Camp Program for Children with Special Needs: "Specialists" for Pre-K- 5th grade

The Statesboro-Bulloch County Parks and Recreation Department strives to provide quality individualized care for children with disabilities based on the specific needs of the child. The "Specialists" Program is an inclusive program, which meets in conjunction with the summer camp program. The "Specialists" Program provides recreational and enrichment activities which allow children with disabilities to participate as they can, making adaptations and modifications to accommodate special needs. The primary responsibility of the Specialists counselor is to make any necessary adaptations/accommodations to program activities which will enable the participant to participate to their fullest potential. Your child will have one on one supervision by a Specialist Staff member who has been trained in providing the right care for your child's needs. The "Specialists" Program is no additional charge, see camp fees.
